Roomunate Bill of Rights compliments of

- 1 The right to sleep and study free from undue interference (noise, music, television, gaming, guests, etc) in your room.
- 2. The right to expect that a roommate will respect your personal belongings.
- 3. The right to a clean living environment.
- 4. The right to free access of your room and facilities without pressure from a roommate.
- 5. The right to privacy.
- (i) The right to be free from fear of intimidation, physical and/or emotional harm.
- 7. The right to expect cooperation in the use of "room-shared" appliances and a commitment to honor agreed-upon payment procedures.
- 8. The right to be free from peer pressure or ridicule if your lifestyle choices differ from your roommate.
- A The right for redress of grievances. Residence hall staff members are available for assistance in settling conflicts. assistance in settling conflicts.
