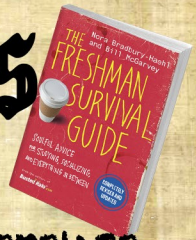


Roommate Bill of Rights

1. The right to sleep and study free from undue interference (noise, music, television, gaming, guests, etc) in your room.

3. The right to a clean living environment.

5. The right to privacy.
6. The right to be free from fear of intimidation, physical and/or emotional harm.
7. The right to expect cooperation in the use of "room-shared" appliances and a commitment to honor agreed-upon payment procedures.
8. The right to be free from peer pressure or ridicule if your lifestyle choices differ from your roommate.
9. The right for redress of grievances. Residence hall staff members are available for assistance in settling conflicts.
